Why are we consulting?

Hackney Council wants to know your views on a proposal to create an Additional Resource Provision (ARP) for pupils with Social, Emotional and Mental Health Needs at Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form.

There has been a significant increase of children and young people with Education, Health and Care Plans (EHCPs) in Hackney. This upward trend in Hackney is predicted to continue and is also being seen across London. Our SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) data tells us that we need to create additional places to cater for children and young people with SEND. This proposal outlines plans to create an ARP (Additional Resource Provision) at Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form by the end of 2025.

Background

Hackney, like other local authorities, has seen a significant rise in the demand for SEND places.

- The number of Hackney children and young people with an EHCP increased from 2,645 in 2021 to 3,062 in 2022 (an increase of 16%).
- The number of Hackney children and young people with an EHCP rose from **3,062** in 2022 to **3,243** in 2023, **equivalent to a 6% increase**.
- The percentage of resident 0-24 year olds in Hackney with an EHCP was the second highest among statistical neighbours (4%), and the 9th highest across England.

We have seen a significant increase in the number of pupils requiring SEND support for Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) Needs in the secondary sector. We know that supporting children with SEND earlier and providing access to targeted support leads to better outcomes and potentially reduces the need for additional support as pupils transition into adulthood. Hackney has a primary ARP for children with Social, Emotional and Mental Health Needs at Gainsborough Primary School but no such provision in a mainstream setting for secondary-aged pupils.

During 2021, the Council asked education providers in Hackney whether they were interested in setting up and managing ARPs for children with SEND to meet the borough's future SEND needs. We welcomed responses from several settings, which included Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form.

Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form is a community secondary school and sixth form in the north-west of the borough, located on Clissold Road, London N16 9EX. The school provides places for 255 pupils in years 7 to 11, and 200 places in the sixth form. The school is rated 'Good' by Ofsted. As of October 2023, the school has 65 pupils with EHCPs. The school's website can be found here.

Our proposal

This consultation seeks views from stakeholders on a proposal to create a 30-place ARP at Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form for pupils with Social, Emotional and Mental Health (SEMH) Needs by the end of 2025.

Children allocated a place at the ARP will have an Education, Health and Care Plan, which identifies SEMH as the primary need. They will receive access to a flexible learning programme and individualised pastoral care. The provision will support pupils to develop personal values, to build maturity, tolerance and sensitivity in personal relationships. Pupils will benefit from clear behaviour management strategies, boundaries and expectations to assist with their academic progress from joining the ARP until the point of leaving the school.

How was Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form chosen for the creation of a new ARP?

In June 2021 Hackney Education contacted schools in the borough to assess whether they wished to offer new provision for children with SEND at their school. We received interest from several schools and settings which were then evaluated against a set of criteria. Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form was among those chosen to set up new provision as part of a wider programme to deliver new SEND provision in Hackney.

How will the ARP at Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form be organised?

ARPs specialise in providing focussed and specific education for SEND needs and will often have dedicated classrooms and other facilities within the school as well as qualified SEND professionals. Children typically spend part of their time in the ARP and the remaining time with their mainstream peers in class. The additional facilities required for the ARP will be provided through the refurbishment of an empty education facility across the road from the main school site.

Admission to the ARP

The allocation of places for the ARP at Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form will be made by the Local Authority's Education, Health and Care Panel using agreed admissions criteria. Thirty ARP places will be provided covering all year groups (7 to 11). All children will have an EHCP identifying Social, Emotional and Mental Health Needs as the primary need. The ARP places will be in addition to the school's Published Admissions Number (PAN).

When will the changes take place?

If the proposals are approved, plans to provide the facility are in the design stages and building work should start on site later in 2024. It is expected that the building works will be completed by the end of 2025.

Who will make the final decision about the new ARP?

Once the consultation period has ended, responses will be analysed and a report will be submitted to Hackney Education's Senior Leadership Team (SLT). If the Senior Leadership Team decides to proceed to the next stage, a statutory notice will be published with the final decision made by the Director of Education.

Further information

Why is the number of children with SEND/Social, Emotional and Mental Health Needs increasing?

The number of children with SEND continues to increase in all settings and school nurseries, reflecting the growing demand for SEND support. Factors that cause or contribute to SEND are not fully understood and agreed, however, it is suggested that the significant increase in rates of SEND seen, may be due to better awareness of the condition as well as increased screening.

How will the new ARP be funded?

The new ARP at Stoke Newington School & Sixth Form is being delivered by the High Needs Provision Capital Allocations (HNPCA) from 2021. This grant is paid to local authorities to support the provision of places for pupils with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) and those children requiring alternative provision.

What will happen if the ARP is delayed?

At this stage, the Council is working to deliver the ARP places by the end of 2025 subject to feasibility studies, planning permissions and works to the school buildings. If this timeline is not achieved the ARP will open as soon as possible after this date.

Are any other new ARPs being developed in Hackney?

We are also consulting on the creation of new ARPs at the following schools:

- Sebright Primary School (Speech, Language and Communication Needs (SLCN) ARP)
- Comet Nursery School & Children's Centre (Early Years ARP)

The Bridge Academy proposes to open a new Cognition and Learning ARP by September 2024. The Academy carried out a separate consultation (on 22 June to 18 July 2023) in line with the guidelines of the Department for Education (DfE). The Academy is in the process of drafting a business case to the DfE for approval to open the new provision.
